- ___ Information about the country's government

- ___ Political map of the country (should include major cities)
- ___ A map of the continent (or entire hemisphere) with your country highlighted
- ___ Description of your relative location

- ___ Information about their land/physical features/climate (3-4 pieces of info)

- ___ A brief timeline of major events of the country (5 – 6 events)

- ___ A graph comparing your country and the United States

- ___ Choose ONE of the following to do an additional slide:
 - ___ Education
 - ___ Natural Resources/Agriculture
 - ___ Economy

- ___ 6 "fast facts" about the country's culture
