- The Great Lakes have already lowered (In the past year, 63 trillion gallons of water has been taken out of the GL)
- When water level drops, the shipping industry suffers because they cannot properly load their ships
- Great Lakes contain wildlife that will be harmed if water is taken out
- There are certain jobs that we do in Michigan that we would not be able to do if we lost our water
- It is not their water.
- People without water should just learn new methods on how to drink their unsafe water.
- If we take the water out, it might not fill back in. (Only 1% of the Great Lakes are renewable)
- People who use the water might pollute it.
- If we send water to other parts of the country, jobs and people might move there too, which will be bad for MI.
- If you give a mouse a cookie.... We might end up losing ALL of our water.
- It will become a way for big businesses to make money.

- 20% of the world's freshwater is in the GL and this is all given to less than 1% of the world's population (0.2%)
- People, including 2 million children, die because they do not have access to safe water
- 33% of Mexico City citizens do not have access to safe drinking water
- Michigan could make money if we were able to sell the water.
- There are children who do not have access to clean water.
- 77 million people lack access to safe water in Latin America.
- All people on Earth deserve access to this basic need.
- We don't need/use ALL the water in the Great Lakes.
- People are getting sick/dying because they don't have access to clean water.
